

Bryan Middle/High School *Arrival and Dismissal Information*

Arrival Process (Please see the map below)

Early Bird Students – The High School Main Office and Commons doors will be open from 6:45am – 7:00am. Students who drive may park in the student parking lot. Students being dropped off may enter the main office door on the High School side of the main office.

Walkers/Riders and Bussing – All doors to the building will open at 7:25am.

Bus Drop Off – Students riding the busses will be dropped off in the parking lot on the west side of the building, located between the football field and new Middle/High School. Students in grades 6-8 arriving prior to 7:45am will report to the commons/cafeteria. All students riding the bus will enter the building through the Athletics entrance on the West side of the building.

Walkers/Parent Drop Off – Beginning at 7:25am, students may enter the building. Any student drop off vehicle must follow the one-way path (noted on the map) when dropping off students. Drop off students may enter the closest main entrance to the building. No vehicles may enter the bus lot.

Student Drivers – Students driving to school must obtain a parking permit and are required to park in the student parking lot (noted on the map). Students may then enter the Commons entrance doors.

Dismissal Process (Please see the map below)

The school day ends at 2:45pm.

Busses – Students riding busses will exit the building on the West side, utilizing the Athletics lobby doors. All busses will be loaded in the West lot, between the new Middle/High School and football field. No vehicles may enter this lot.

Student Pick-up – Any student being picked up will walk to their vehicle located within the one-way drop off/pick-up zone. The traffic flow will be identical to the morning arrival, requiring all vehicles to follow the one-way traffic pattern.

Student Drivers – Please be cautious as you exit the campus. Please be advised that there is no access to Barrister Road.

Please exercise patience and flexibility as we all learn our new traffic patterns and traffic flow!
