BCS BUS RIDING RULES
“DON’T LOSE YOUR RIDING PRIVILEGE!”

1. OBSERVE SAME CONDUCT AS IN THE CLASSROOM
2. OBEY BUS DRIVER PROMPTLY AND RESPECTFULLY
3. BE ON TIME FOR THE BUS TO FOLLOW TIME SCHEDULE
4. SILENCE AT RAILROAD CROSSINGS
5. BUS DRIVER WILL ASSIGN SEATS
6. NO STANDING - NOTHING IN THE AISLE

**(MUST SIT IN THE SEAT~ BOTTOM ON BOTTOM, BACK ON
BACK, FEET ON THE FLOOR, FACING FORWARD)**

7. KEEP BUS CLEAN - KEEP ITEMS IN BOOK BAG
8. KEEP HEAD, HANDS AND FEET INSIDE THE BUS
9. NO PROFANE LANGUAGE, NO LOUD TALKING OR LAUGHING
10. BE RESPECTFUL TO OTHERS
11. NO CELL PHONE USAGE
12. DO NOT BE DESTRUCTIVE
13. DO NOT CHEW GUM ON THE BUS
14. DO NOT EAT OR DRINK

(KEEP ALL CUPS AND BOTTLES INSIDE BOOK BAGS AT ALL TIMES)

15. **REMAIN SEATED UNTIL THE BUS STOPS TO UNLOAD**; WAIT FOR THE SIGNAL FROM THE BUS DRIVER AND THEN CROSS THE ROAD IN FRONT OF THE BUS
