# **Random Student Drug Testing Policy:**

Mrs. Savage presented a draft of the district's proposed random drug testing program. By initiating this program, it provides students another reason to say no to drugs. The program would require students participating in athletics or any extra-curricular program to participate. The board would need to determine which substances would be tested for such as nicotine, marijuana, etc. The policy outlines the collection process, penalties for violations, and an appeals process. Mrs. Savage has a few items yet to clarify with our attorney regarding the new program. The board asked several questions and commented on the positive impact this program could provide. Mrs. Savage will finalize the policy and present it to the Board for further discussion.
